

Remember the Beauty and Blessing of Belonging

We invite you to REMEMBER in COMMUNITY and then RESPOND in love to one another.

Here are a few creative ways you can use these cards and scripture guide:

FAMILY MEALS:

Print out the cards and scripture guide and put them in a basket on your kitchen table. Draw one card and have a family member read the corresponding scripture. Discuss what the passage means and then challenge one another to live out that truth the following day. As you gather for your family meal the next night, you can reflect on how you applied the one-another passage from the night before and also read and respond to the next one-another truth.

POST ON THE DOOR POSTS OF YOUR HOME:

Print out the cards and place them in places that will help you to remember...over the kitchen sink, on the bathroom mirror, or in your car. As you look at them daily, use the truths as a teachable moment to reinforce how we love and serve one another with your family.

ENCOURAGEMENT CARDS FOR OTHERS:

Prayerfully read through the cards. Ask God to bring people to your heart that you know would be encouraged by that particular scripture. Then share them with others.

You could print out:

- Praying for those in your life: Ephesians 6:18 and then mail it in a card.
- Bearing others' burdens in practical ways: Galatians 6:2 and tape it to a neighbor's garbage can when you roll it back to their home.
- Showing generous hospitality to others: I Peter 4:9 and include it in a note or text to invite others to come and share a meal with your family.
- Welcoming one another with the grace of the gospel: Romans 15:7 and tape it to the top of a plate of your family's favorite goodies and share them with your neighbor.
- Serving those around you: I Peter 4:10 and tape it to a bag of food or supplies that you could pick up and deliver to an older member in your church.
- Encouraging one another: I Thessalonians 5:11a and tape it to an anonymous gift that you leave on your friend's porch.

You could even print out a complete set for another person and put them in a basket or jar wrapped in a bow. Invite them to remember with you!
